Traineeships provide the perfect opportunity to get young adults into work and onto a full apprenticeship programme. Individuals must be between 16-24 inclusive and includes people with learning difficulties or education, health and care plans.

The traineeships programme has 3 core elements.

- work preparation training
- English and maths support, if required
- work placement

Deere Apprenticeships provide a unique "Workskills" course preparing the individuals for work, discovering the potential often locked in young people, removing the barriers to employment and providing support to the individual in order for them to progress in their chosen career.

Fundamental to the progress is the increased level in Functional Skills, English, Maths and ICT (if required) are taught in a functional way that applies to everyday life. Deere Apprenticeships will teach and support the individuals to achieve the necessary grades that will increase their employability likelihood.

Deere Apprenticeships will work with employers to establish positive work placements that provide the opportunity for the individuals to progress onto a full apprenticeship programme.
